## ACCUBOOST

### Bothwell first in state to add AccuBoost treatment option for breast cancer

Bothwell has brought to Sedalia a relatively uncommon technology to treat early-stage breast cancer. Bothwell's Susan O'Brien Fischer Cancer Center is the first in Missouri to offer the treatment option known as AccuBoost.

The treatment is thought to be safer and more effective than traditional methods, particularly for patients who opt for Breast Conservation Therapy (BCT).

Here's how it works: When a woman gets a lumpectomy, she typically

undergoes several weeks of radiation to keep cancer cells from spreading to surrounding tissue. These treatments have drawbacks, such as burns on the skin and “scatter” radiation that can hit healthy organs.

AccuBoost instead uses a mammography machine to compress the breast and special applicators that deliver a much more precise dose of radiation to the targeted area. The tungsten applicators direct the radiation exactly where it’s needed and away from where it’s not. Because the therapy is non-intrusive, AccuBoost also eliminates device-related infections and complications.

“We’re excited to be the first cancer center in Missouri to bring this technology to our patients,” said Tom Bailey, chief operating officer at Bothwell. “When we talk about scatter dose, the less is better, and with AccuBoost, the radiation can be targeted much more precisely where it’s needed, sparing the normal tissue from the radiation.”

Not every breast cancer patient needs boost treatment, but having the technology gives patients who do qualify for it, another treatment option. The hospital also is raising money to purchase a stereotactic table to help with diagnosis.

“We also have added a breast coil, which allows us to perform MRIs of the breast,” Bailey said. That also helps to make a more accurate diagnosis.

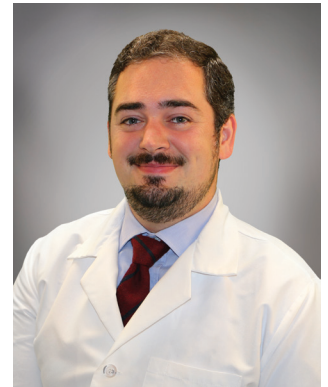
