



Financial Assistance Policy Summary

The Bothwell Regional Health Center Financial Assistance Policy (FAP) exists to provide eligible patients or other responsible parties partially or fully discounted emergency or medically- necessary care. Patients or financially responsible parties that are seeking financial assistance (FA) must apply through an application process.

Eligible Services: Emergency and/or medically necessary healthcare services provided by Bothwell Regional Health Center and associated primary care clinics.

Eligible Patients: Patients receiving eligible services, who submit a completed Financial Assistance (FA) application (including related documentation and information), and who are determined eligible for FA by Bothwell Regional Health Center's Director of Patient Financial Services.

How to Apply: FA applications may be obtained/ completed/ submitted as follows:

- Obtain an application at any Bothwell Regional Health Center facility registration desks.
- Request to have an application mailed to you or if you have any questions call 660-827-9418

Determination of Financial Assistance Eligibility-

Generally, patients are eligible for financial assistance based on their income level and household size. Patients with family income of 200% of federal poverty level or less may be eligible for a discount up to 100%. Patients with income under 200% of the federal poverty level may be eligible for a discount from 5%- 100%.

Eligible patients will not be charged for emergency or other medically necessary care, more than the Amount Generally Billed (AGB), based on Medicaid fee-for-service and commercial insurance rates.
