The Bothwell Foundation has been busy this year with numerous projects. With your support, we have been able to fund the following projects:

- Funded a new nursing internship program at Bothwell Regional Health Center
- Awarded more than \$9,800 in scholarships
- Funded Halo Sleep Sacks to promote safe sleep habits for babies. Each baby born at Bothwell Regional Health Center will receive one starting in 2018
- Purchased six special recliners for patients in the Outpatient Infusion Center
- Purchased a Jaszczak Phantom to be used in Bothwell's Radiology department to help maintain high quality imaging standards on Bothwell's nuclear medicine equipment
- Provided grants to Benton County Hospice and Crossroads Hospice, which serve patients in Pettis and Benton County.

Foundation-funded Equipment Helps Patient Comfort in Cancer Center



Leadership and physicians in the Susan O'Brien Fischer Cancer Center understand the importance of comfort for their patients, especially those undergoing chemo and radiation. Knowing it is a stressful and emotional time for their patients, they are constantly looking for ways to improve technology and relieve some of that stress and unease.

Dr. William Decker, radiation oncologist at Bothwell Regional Health Center, recognized a need for lung cancer patients that he was treating. These patients undergo extremely precise radiation therapy procedures in which a large dose of radiation is administered to a very specific location. In order to accomplish this, patients have to be as still as possible. The patient's movements must be limited, and the previous system used a heavy plastic drape that was placed over the patient. Often times this caused a



sense of claustrophobia and was very uncomfortable for the patient.


To improve this for these patients, Dr. Decker worked with Jason Sharp, director of cancer services, to request funding from the Bothwell Foundation for the new Civco Body Pro-Lok Immobilization System. This system allows patients to be immobilized in a more secure manner, which then allows them better control of breathing and body movements with a more open design. Dr. Decker is now using this system, and says the new technology is much more comfortable for the patients.

"The equipment and funds we have received from the Foundation have been wonderful for the cancer center. With the funds provided through the Foundation's Gene Loveall Cancer Fund, the cancer center has been able to purchase equipment to help our patients be more comfortable, provide Ensure to help our patients receive nutritional supplement during their treatments, and make gas gift cards available for patients with financial needs to get back and forth to treatments. Our patients appreciate all the Foundation does and are very thankful to have these options available to them," said Dr. Decker.




Dollars Making Sense

On average, 500 babies are born at Bothwell Regional Health Center each year. In 2018, the Foundation will provide each baby born at the hospital a Halo Sleep Sack that promotes safe sleep habits and helps reduce the occurrence of SIDS.

Since March 2017, more than 360 cases of Ensure has been given to chemotherapy and radiation patients in the Susan O'Brien Fischer Cancer Center at Bothwell Regional Health Center.

Since the Foundation was formed in 2005, more than \$3.6 Million has been given back to Bothwell Regional Health Center and to our local community.

DONOR SPOTLIGHT: **The First Gift — Investing in Our Community**

In times of trouble, our hospital stands ready — a safety net — no matter the situation. Bothwell Regional Health Center would not be here without the founding gift from John Homer Bothwell. We are deeply appreciative of this gift, and continue to celebrate the support it offers to our community for all the years to come.

John Homer Bothwell, known as Homer to his friends, was a prominent Sedalia resident, founder of Stonyridge Lodge, now known as the Bothwell Lodge State Park, and business partner for the Hotel Bothwell. Bothwell, who was born Nov. 20, 1848, moved to Pettis County in 1871 and served Sedalia in many ways during his life, including as assistant prosecuting attorney and president of the Sedalia Board of Trade. He also represented Sedalia in the Missouri General Assembly.

Mr. Bothwell recognized the need for expanded medical services in Sedalia. Motivated in part by a desire to draw the State Fair to Sedalia, he strove to improve resources in Sedalia, which included his business ventures to help start the hotel and the hospital. He promised Sedalia residents he would contribute \$100,000 to build the hospital, provided they helped to raise the balance of the funds needed to finish the project. Bonds were passed and the community raised the other half. The health center, which opened in October 1930, is to this day named after Mr. Bothwell.


