## Letter from the Board President

hat a year 2018 has been...from Lub Dub in April to the Bothwell Benefit last month and everything in between.

This year, thanks to sponsors of our events, participants, volunteers and the overall generosity of those in Pettis and Benton counties, we have been able to raise more than \$220,000. Lub Dub hosted a record number of participants this year. Almost daily, we get more Bothwell employees, Senior Leadership Team members and trustees to support the Foundation through annual donations and payroll deductions. The Bothwell Benefit tickets sold out well in advance of the event, and those who attended had giving in their heart and gave over \$106,000 in just one night.

So far this year, we have granted over \$30,000 for a variety of items, including scholarships, patient assistance, Ensure and gas cards for cancer patients, aid for hospice care and AEDs for Benton County facilities. We also sponsored the Cancer Center's survivor's day and a free 3-D mammography day. Both of these events were so successful that we are considering expanding our funding of them for next year. Gas cards for the wound center, iPads for stroke patients and white boards for 2 Southwest also received funding from our Foundation.


With the money raised from this year's Bothwell Benefit, Pinktober events, employee donations, and with donations we will solicit after the first of the year, the Foundation will purchase a Stereotactic Breast Biopsy system for the hospital. This will help our surgeons more expeditiously diagnose and treat our breast cancer patients.

I cannot say thank you enough to all of those who have made this year one of the most productive in the short history of the Bothwell Foundation. Because of you, we can make a difference in health care in Pettis and Benton counties. We are looking forward to doing even more in 2019.

## DONOR SPOTLIGHT: Bothwell Foundation Remembers the Lovealls

Gene and Frances Loveall at a reception given in their honor for the \$100,000 donation they made to the Bothwell Foundation in 2011.

t is with heavy hearts that the Bothwell Foundation bids a fond farewell to Gene Loveall who passed in August this year. Gene and his wife Frances leave a legacy of kindness and generosity that will continue to make a difference in years to come.

In 2003 Frances suffered a stroke and after four long weeks of driving back and forth to Columbia, Gene was able to bring her back to Sedalia where she received care in the Skilled Nursing Unit and then by the Cardiac Rehabilitation department at Bothwell Regional Health Center.

Several years later in 2008 Gene received treatment himself at Bothwell when he battled prostate cancer. Gene had praised radiation oncologist Dr. William Decker and the staff of the Susan O'Brien Fischer Cancer Center for the treatment and care after his diagnosis.

Inspired by the care they both received at Bothwell, in 2011 the Lovealls decided to make a \$100,000 donation to the Bothwell Foundation. So the Frances Loveall Stroke Recovery Fund and the Gene Loveall Cancer Services Fund were established.

"The Lovealls knew firsthand how important these services are to the community, and their donation will help other patients who face the same health issues," stated Dave Floyd, former Foundation board president.

And help other patients they have. Their donation was divided evenly between the two funds and was invested. Through the interest income earned off these investments as well as additional donations, these two funds have been able to provide various pieces of equipment and other items to benefit patients at the hospital. From iPads for stroke recovery patients to gas cards for patients who have to travel for cancer care, this couple's generous spirit continues to touch many lives.

The Lovealls were a rare and beautiful couple—poised and genteel while still being down to earth and warm. Their presence will be missed, but their legacy of generosity will continue for years to come. **Thank you, Gene and Frances!** 

#### 2018 Funding Recap

The Bothwell Foundation has been busy this year with numerous projects. With your support, we have been able to fund the following projects:

- Provided grants to Benton County Hospice and Crossroads Hospice, which serve patients in Pettis and Benton County.

On Oct. 1, the Bothwell Foundation kicked-off a campaign to raise funds that will be used towards the purchase of a stereotactic breast biopsy system for Bothwell Regional Health Center. Purchasing this important piece of equipment will allow our patients to get results sooner and to receive care (from screenings to treatment) all within our own community.

**Stereotactic Campaign Update** 

This system, which currently is here only a couple days a month, will be used to biopsy suspicious spots that are found during a mammogram. The overall project cost to purchase a system is estimated at \$200,000. By purchasing the stereotactic breast biopsy system, Bothwell Regional Health Center will be the only facility with a full-time stereotactic unit between Kansas City and Columbia.

#### **Coffee Punch Recipe**

#### Ingredients

- 1/3 cup Instant Coffee
- 2 cups Granulated Sugar (can use less)
- 1 cup Water
- 1/2 Gallon Vanilla Ice Cream
- 1/2 Gallon Chocolate Ice Cream
- 1 Gallon Whole or 2% Milk

#### Directions

In small pan, combine instant coffee, sugar & water and heat until the sugar has dissolved and all the ingredients are well mixed and hot. Don't boil!

Refrigerate the mixture in an airtight container until you are ready to use. The liquid will be syrupy.

Before serving, pour the chilled syrup into a large punch bowl. Add the gallon of milk if punch bowl allows and stir well. Add ice cream by scoops into the punch. Stir gently to mix. The ice cream will keep the punch cold.


